What another busy week! We have continued to learn about 'focusing' and 'persevering' and have now been trying to demonstrate good 'Teamwork'.


In Phonics the children have started to apply their developing knowledge and recognition of i,n,m and d into blending together cvc words, together with the sounds that we learnt last week; s,a,t and p. We hope that you found the Phonics workshop informative with some useful ideas on how you can support your child at home.

In Literacy, our focus book of the week has been 'Goldilocks and the Three Bears'. The children thought Goldilocks was quite naughty and made some 'Wanted' posters and called the police! Goldilocks also wrote a letter to say sorry and the children worked together to build a new chair for baby bear.

Meg (the maths puppet) has been busy this week using her cauldron to teach us about numbers 8,9,10 and 11. We have been carefully counting out objects from the Goldilocks story to match to a number, using a number line to help us.

Home Learning: Can you make some 3 letter words using the sounds; s,a,t,p,i,n,m or d? They can be real words or alien nonsense words.

Next week: In our Literacy sessions we will be looking at non fiction books on pets. We have two new, tiny, furry additions to our Foundation unit on Monday. Very exciting! We will be learning all about how to look after them and giving them new names.
