This week the children have had a super week being sporty and active. In Literacy we have been continuing our Pirate theme with 'Pirates Love Underpants' and the children have designed their favourite pair of pants and written sentences and stories about them. In Maths we have had a fantastic week learning about and applying our positional language. We have completed obstacle courses going in, on, under, through, down, up and next to just to name a few. The children have worked as a team to hide objects and describe to their friends where they are using positional language and have worked in their groups to complete some brilliant team challenges.

Whilst focusing on team work and encouragement - we have been able to practice our Sports Day activities in preparation for Monday.
