## 7th - 11th October

The children have had a super week this week learning some new sounds in Phonics - g,o,c and k. We have loved applying them in words and seeing if we can find objects beginning with them in the classroom and outside. We have been practising to form them in literacy and write them in cvc words. Can your child remember the ditty for each formation?

In Maths this week Meg has taught us 8,9,10 and 11 and we have been applying the correct amount of objects to the numeral. We have really enjoyed doing this with buttons on Gingerbread Men. Next week we are going to be baking our own Gingerbread Men with Ellen and using smarties to count the buttons - if you do not want your child to take part in this please let a member of the team know. I hope the Gingerbread Men don't run away!

We have had such a busy week this week and it was lovely to see so many family members at our class lunches and Harvest Assembly - I think you will agree that the children were fantastic, we were so proud of them all.

Can you believe that it is nearly half term already? The children's first term in school has certainly flown by and we are so impressed with their enthusiasm for school life, their friends and a love of learning. Next week we have Parent's and Carers evenings on Tuesday and Thursday so please make sure you have signed up for a slot on eSchools. The home learning that we have been receiving is just brilliant. The children are loving sharing it with their friends and also their home Tapestry observations too. There is no set number of observations they will receive per term and each child may have them uploaded at different times so do not worry if friends parents have received some and you have not just yet.
