## Dear Parent/Carer,

Applications are now open for children who are in Year 3 to Year 6 to learn a musical instrument from November. Learning an instrument is great for self-confidence, discipline, improving memory, and teaching perseverance.

We offer lessons in: piano/keyboard/drums/guitar/violin/cello/clarinet/flute, ukulele and cornet. We have a small stock of instruments in bold that we can hire out for £10 until Christmas. For guitar/ukulele it is more cost effective to source an instrument yourself.

There will be 5 lessons in November/December to give your child a taste of whether you would like to sign up for a full block of 10 lessons in January. Group lessons will take place within year group bubbles and the lesson length includes time for the tutor to clean equipment etc. between pupils/groups.

Each tutor may have slightly different prices.
