In Maths this week our 3D shape of the week has been a cuboid and we have been learning about its' 6 faces, 8 vertices and 12 edges. We looked for cuboids in our environment and thought that lego and duplo were good examples. We have been subtracting this week and writing subtraction sentences such as  $8 - 4 = 4$ , we drew 8 pancakes and crossed them off as we took them away (pretended to eat - yum)!
