We have had a lovely week in Foundation this week learning about rhyme including singing different nursery rhymes, writing rhyming words and writing rhyming captions. In Phonics this week, Len has introduced 4 new sounds to us: j, v, w and x. Can you practice writing these words at home using the correct letter formation? jet, wet, vet, fox, next

Can you segment each word for spelling? Can you think of other words using those sounds? Remember that writing these words and practising the sounds does not just have to be on paper - it can be in bubbles in the bath, mud, sand - anywhere you can think of!

The children have also learnt four new tricky words. Tricky words cannot be sounded out and are words we have to remember by sight. This week we have taught he, she, we and me.

We have also been learning to write rhyming captions using finger spaces and a capital letter. Can you write:

## The cat sat on the mat.

Please feel free to bring these into school so that we can share them in class in whichever way you would like to record or share through Tapestry.

Meg this week has been helping us to find the total number of two groups. She tried to do some spells but ended up making the number 10 Numicon disappear! We then have to record number sentences to find different ways to make 10 and PROVE IT by counting the total number.

Home Learning: Every Christmas in Foundation we like to do things that encourage the children about kindness and helping others. Each class makes a 'reverse advent calendar' and instead of one child per day having a treat, we add an item of food into a class box to build up a box of food to take to the food bank.
