Welcome back after what I hope was a lovely week for you all! Thank you so much for sharing your home learning and adventures on Tapestry – we have enjoyed sharing these with the children.

This week in Literacy our focus book has been 'Meg's Veg' by Helen Nicoll and Jan Pienkowski and the children have loved to learn, paint, draw, count and explore using vegetables and pumpkins. We even went around the school looking for sounds hidden on pumpkins to practise our letter formation and to write real and nonsense words – how exciting.

In Phonics this week we have learnt four new phonemes ck, e, u and r. We have also learnt two tricky words – these are words that we cannot sound out and are **to** and **the**.

In Maths, Meg has been making some very sneaky spells and has been tricking us by hiding some numbers from our number line. Her spells were definitely going wrong so we had to help her to see if we could find them, put them in the right place and count to see if they were now in the right order.

Isn't Meg lucky that she has us all to help! Our numbers of the week have been 16, 17, 18 and 19.

Following our theme this week, we have been learning about change over time and have learnt about seasons and how seeds turn into vegetables. We have talked about what they need to grow and how we can help them.
