Wow – what an amazing week we have had completing our Balancability course provided by the Plymouth Schools Partnership. We are so very proud of the children for their effort, commitment and overcoming fears. It has been amazing to see their progress – well done all!

Due to our daily Balancability sessions, our timetable has been structured slightly differently but we have still ensured that Len has introduced four new sounds and Meg has helped us with our Firework maths, discussing less/fewer and the same and adding one more.

This week we have been talking about Non-Fiction books in Literacy and looking at Fireworks, Bonfire Night and safety posters. The children have written a simple rule and have written real and alien words for the sounds they can hear in fireworks. Len has introduced four new sounds: **h, b, f (and double ff) l (and double ll) and double ss**. Our tricky words this week have been **no, go** and **I**

Can you practice writing these words at home using the correct letter formation? Can you segment each word for spelling?
