This involved the pre-arranged sounding of the bell on Friday morning so that the new Foundation children could be warned it was going to go off and learn what it was for while the teachers in other year groups could use it as a reminder to talk with their class about what their evacuation route from their new classroom would be. A full practice evacuating the building would then happen next week. However, by accident, the alarm was triggered at that very moment! It is always a 'heart in your mouth' moment as the Headteacher when the alarm goes off and you now that it is not a planned practice. However, once the initial relief was passed that it was a false alarm and the fire brigade called to say that they were not needed I took my position on the playground to supervise the evacuation. Oh My Word. I wish it had been filmed so that I could have shared it with you so you could have seen just how incredible your 642 children were. They filed out in total silence, lined up in bubbles (which we were going to practice next week) and they stayed focused and alert. All adults and children were out swiftly and were accounted for. As for Foundation Stage – the rest of the school gave them a round of applause as they did so well. I was a very, very proud Headteacher as I stood in front of everyone. And on another positive, as Miss Spragg pointed out to me, how lovely it was to see the whole school together for the first time in such a long time. So, fire practice ticked off! Knocked it out of the park!

Free School Meal

If you receive certain benefits, you may be entitled to claim free school meals. Plymouth City Council is able to check your eligibility online, therefore minimising the need to provide proof of your entitlement.

It is of great benefit for our school if you are entitled to free school meals as we could receive extra school funding for all children who qualify.

Even if your child is aged 4 to 7, and would qualify for Universal Free School Meals, we would encourage you to register for free-school-meals, if you think that you may be entitled under any of the benefits.




