If you have requested a universal school lunch, these will be provided on the day. **If you have not requested a lunch from school, please ensure that your child brings in a packed lunch from home.** Children will be provided with a fruit snack as usual in the morning.

Please ensure that your child brings in a named rucksack for the trip. This will need to be big enough to hold a water bottle, your child's lunch and their coat. They will not need to bring their book bag to school on the day.
