## Dear Parent/Guardian

Plymouth Argyle Football in the Community Trust is delighted to be holding an After School Club at Montpelier Primary School ( $3.15 \mathrm{pm}-4.15 \mathrm{pm}$ ) for girls in vear $1 / 2$ on Fridays after Easter, running until the May half-term

The course will run for 5 weeks commencing on Friday $17^{\text {th }}$ April 2020 and will finish on Friday $22^{\text {nd }}$ May 2020(Friday May $8^{\text {th }}$ is now a bank holiday). The cost would usually be $£ 18$, however, the school will part-fund the course and are requesting a contribution of $£ 8$ for the entire 5 week block of sessions. Numbers are limited, so if more than 16 children wish to attend, the school will draw the names out at random. Forms must be completed and handed into the Year 1 or year 2 team, who will then pass them onto Mr Robinson (PE Coordinator) by Friday 20 th March. No money is required yet, as this is just an expression of interest.

You will be informed if your child has been successful in gaining a place in this club by Tuesday 24th March, with details of how to pay also. Those who are unsuccessful will be placed on a waiting list in case a place becomes available. If the club proves popular, the school will look to run a second club later on in the year for those girls on the waiting list.

All of the children who attend the course should have a parent/guardian collect them from school reception by 4.15 pm on Fridays.

Children will need to bring with them trainers, shin pads, and a drink, as well wearing their own football kit, such as a team (or school PE kit). Argyle's coaches are CRB checked, hold a UEFA coaching qualification and have Emergency First Aid Training. If you have any questions or queries, please do not hesitate to contact Mr Robinson or a member of the Year 1 or Year 2 team in school.
