Time	Activity
14:00 approximate	Arrive at Trafalgar Square London <i>All bags and belongings will be left on the coach.</i>
14:00 – 16:30 approximate	Sightseeing walk from Trafalgar Square to Buckingham Palace via The Mall. Time to spend in St James' Park.
16:30 approximate	Evening Meal
17:30	Depart Trafalgar Square on the coach and head to the Science Museum

Science Museum - Astronights

Time	Activity
18:45	Arrive at Science Museum <i>Get shown to sleeping area and secure belongings</i>
19:30 – 23:00 approximate	Children take part in three organised activities/ workshops hosted by staff from the Science Museum <i>At approximately 20:30 children will have time for a small snack which should be provided by parents.</i> <i>Montpelier staff will also be supporting the activities</i>
23:00 approximate	Sleep time <i>Children settle down to sleep in secure space in and around exhibits accompanied by all Montpelier adults in addition to Science Museum staff who will also supervise the overnight stay. We will sleep as a group in the same area and will not be split up. Roll mat will be provided.</i>

Science Museum – Astronights

Time	Activity
06:15	Wake up call <i>Children to get ready for the day and pack up their belongings</i>
07:00	Breakfast served (continental)
07:30 approximate	Children to watch an IMAX film in the Science Museum Packed lunch provided by parents to be eaten at a service station <i>Exact time and location will be dependant on the day</i>
09:00 approximate	Explore the laboratory for an hour <i>Children will have access to parts of the Science Museum before it opens up to the public</i>
10:00	Depart from the Science Museum via coach which will be waiting outside
12:30 approximate	Stop at a service station for lunch
16:00 approximate	Arrive back to Plymouth <i>We aim to be back as close to 16:00 as possible. Should there be any changes we will contact parents</i> <i>Please ensure that you collect your child in the same place as you dropped them off. All children will need to be collected by an adult.</i>

What to pack

It is vital that children wear mufti with a green school jumper as well as a pair of sensible trainers/walking shoes. Below is a list of items we would like your child to bring with them inside their backpack:

- ✓ **Packed lunch**
for them to eat on Friday lunchtime
- ✓ **Packed evening snack**
small snack -fruit/ crisp/ biscuits etc.
- ✓ **Sleeping bag**
- ✓ **Pillow (optional)**
- ✓ **Refillable water bottle**
Important to be able to refill at the child's leisure throughout the day and night
- ✓ **Toothbrush and toothpaste**
- ✓ **Clean underwear for the Saturday**
Please note: children do not need to bring a change of clothing as they will wear home the clothes they arrive in
- ✓ **Pyjamas**
- ✓ **Wear a waterproof coat and suitable clothing and footwear.**
Suitable clothing will be defined by the weather at the time of the trip

If children bring anything additional to the list provided it will be at their own risk.

What not to pack

Following the guidance from the Science Museum and to maximise the enjoyment of our trip, we ask that children do not bring the following items:
