## Dear Parent/Carer,

Applications are now open for children who will be in Year 2 to Year 6 in September to learn a musical instrument in the Autumn Term. Learning an instrument is great for self confidence, discipline, improving memory, and teaching perseverance.

We offer lessons in piano/keyboard/drums/guitar/violin/cello/clarinet/flute, ukulele and cornet. We have a small stock of instruments in bold type that we can hire out for £20 a term. For guitar/ukulele it is more cost effective to source an instrument yourself.

Lessons are offered in a block of ten each term, which allows for weeks to be missed for swimming, INSET days, school trips etc. Each tutor may have slightly different prices. **5 weeks notice is required to terminate lessons**.

Children eligible for Pupil premium can receive free lessons- please contact me, stating which instrument your child would like to learn.

If your child has learnt this year, in school, they need to re enrol for September
